



MĀORI RADIO COVERAGE

Māori Radio Stations can be accessed from Kaitaia in the north, to Wellington in the south, from Kaikoura to Christchurch, and in Timaru, Dunedin and Invercargill. While there are some areas that have no access to Māori Radio, the vast majority of the Māori population can receive at least one Māori Radio Station signal. Stations can also be accessed online via www.maorimedia.co.nz

Station & Frequencies	Primary Broadcast Area
AWA FM Whanganui (91.0FM, 93.5FM, 100.0FM)	The Awa FM frequency can be accessed throughout the Whanganui and Rangitikei districts. The signal can be received as far south as Bulls and Marton, and as far north as Ohakune. This area includes Kaiwi, Whangaehu, Ratana, Raetihi, Turakina, Whanganui and other small settlements situated along the Whanganui river. Awa FM also broadcasts into Taumarunui.
KIA ORA FM Palmerston North (89.8FM)	Palmerston North, Sanson, Bulls, Dannevirke, Woodville, Eketahuna, Pahiatua, Foxton, Feilding, Marton, Kimbolton.
MOANA RADIO Tauranga (1440AM, 98.2FM)	Extends from Tauranga city and covers Mt Maunganui, Papamoa Beach, Maketū, Te Puke and Katikati (frequency can also be received as far east as Whakatāne and even Te Kaha).
NGĀ IWI FM Paeroa (92.2FM, 92.4FM, 92.7FM, 92.8FM, 99.6FM, 105.1FM)	Includes Paeroa, Thames, Thames Coast (up to Kereta), Waihi, Ngatea, the surrounding Hauraki Plains, and parts of Huntly.
NGĀTI HINE FM Whangarei (99.1FM, 99.6FM)	Coverage is from Kaikohe to the Brenderwyns, and from Horokaka to the Bay of Islands. Two transmitter sites – one off Parihaka in Whangarei covering the town, and one off Hikurangi north of Kaikohe.
RADIO KAHUNGUNU Napier (765AM, 94.3FM)	Stretches from the Māhia Peninsula in the north, through to the township of Dannevirke in the south. This frequency area includes the cities of Napier and Hastings, and also the townships of Nuhaka, Mohaka, Wairoa, Te Hauke, Te Aute, Waipawa, Otane, Waipukurau, Bridge Pa, Clive, Omahu, Bayview, Potaka, Pakipaki and Waimarama. There is a strong argument that the actual frequency area is much larger than this.
RADIO MANIAPOTO Te Kuiti (91.8FM, 92.7FM, 99.6FM, 106.2FM)	Signal can be accessed from Piopio, Bennydale, Waitomo which includes Te Kuiti, Otorohanga and Waipa, including Te Awamutu – north up to Te Rapa, Hamilton.
RADIO NGĀTI POROU Ruatoria/East Coast (585AM, 89.3FM, 90.5FM, 98.5FM, 105.3FM, 106.5FM)	Stretches from Hicks Bay in the north through to the city of Gisborne. This frequency area includes Te Araroa, Tikitiki, Ruatoria, Te Puia Springs, Waipiro Bay, Tokomaru Bay and Tolaga Bay. The station can also be received in Matawai, but only in selected areas.

RADIO TAINUI Ngaruawahia/Waikato (95.4FM, 95.7FM, 96.5FM, 106.4)	Covers the whole of the Waikato region. The frequency can be received as far north as South Auckland, and south to Tokoroa. This area includes Kawhia Moana, Raglan, Morrinsville, Cambridge and across the Hauraki Plains.
RADIO WAATEA Auckland (603AM)	Covers the greater Auckland, stretching from Whangaparoa to the Bombay hills (frequency can also be received as far north as Kaikohe, and south into Waikato and Taranaki).
RAUKAWA FM Tokoroa (90.6FM, 93.2FM, 95.7FM)	Includes the settlements of Tokoroa, Mangakino, Matamata, Te Aroha, Cambridge, Karapiro, Tirau, Putaruru and Hamilton.
TUMEKE FM Whakatane (96.9FM)	Signal can be accessed across the eastern Bay of Plenty. The frequency can be received in Whakatāne, Ohope, Taneatua, Ruatoki, Kawerau, Kutarere, Edgumbe, Thorndon, Matata and Murupara.
TAHU FM Kaikoura (90.7FM), Christchurch (90.5FM), Timaru (89.1FM), Dunedin (95.0FM), Invercargill (99.6FM), Sky Digital 423	Signal can be accessed throughout the south island, from Kaikoura in the north to Taitapu, just south of Christchurch. The station also broadcasts into Dunedin and Invercargill on separate signals. Tahu FM can also be accessed nationwide on its Sky TV channel.
TAUTOKO FM Mangamuka Bridge (97.2FM, 97.5FM, 99.5FM, 105.3FM)	Signal can be accessed from the Mangamuka gorge in the north, through to Whangarei in the south. This area includes Kaikohe, Waitangi, Paihia, Russell and a number of other small Northland communities. Whangarei has not been included as part of Tautoko FM's primary broadcast area.
TE ARAWA FM Rotorua (88.7FM, 88.9FM, 91.8FM, 93.9FM)	Covers the general city area of Rotorua. The frequency cannot be received past the turn off to state highway 30, north east of Rotorua, or state highway 5 north of Ngongotaha.
TE HIKU O TE IKA Kaitia (97.1FM) & Tai FM (106.7FM) [Rangatahi]	Covers the far north of the North Island. While the frequency can be received from the Mangamuka ranges to the North Cape. Te Hiku Media broadcasts different frequencies for Te Hiku o Te Ika and Tai FM [Rangatahi/Youth].
TE KORIMAKO O TARANAKI New Plymouth (94.8FM, 97.6FM, 98.4FM)	Signal can be accessed from Waverley in the south through to Mokau in the north, and inland to Ohura. This area includes Waitara, Inglewood, Stratford, Eltham, Hawera, Manaia, parts of Oakura and the city of New Plymouth.
TE ŪPOKO O TE IKA Wellington (1161AM)	Signal can be accessed through out the Wellington region and north into Horowhenua, Manawatu, Wanganui and southern Taranaki, and as far South as Te Tau Ihi o te Waka a Maui.
TURANGA FM Gisborne (91.7FM, 95.7FM, 98.1FM)	Stretches from Whangara in the north to Mahia and Wairoa in the south. This includes Gisborne city, Matawhero, Manutuke and Matawai.
TŪWHARETOA FM Turangi (89.4FM, 92.0FM, 95.1FM, 97.6FM, 100.6FM)	Signal can be accessed as far south as Waiouru and covers from Turangi to Mangakino, Taupo, Kaingaroa, Rainbow Mt, Tumunui, Tokoroa in the North. National Park to Taumararui in the West. To the east along Napier/Taupo Highway 5.
